Bearings:

A cheap bearing can let you down, always get a bearing from a reputable manufacturer, check for the correct heat range (usually in the workshop manual and marked on the side of the outer race) and if not a sealed bearing use a good quality grease, preferably synthetic and remember over packing a bearing can be worse than
